Since 2015 the project of Corbynism has grown, becoming more vital and necessary as the stakes around us have risen. However, those who joined the movement on the promise of building a new, democratic and socialist party have failed to cohere into a form adequate to the opportunity presented to us. As such we are building a Network of Anti-Capitalist Labour Members organising for Socialism.

What we are doing:

For many, the party has proven to be a frustrating labyrinth; our local CLPs hardly reflect the dynamic content of the movement we read about online. It's often been hard to know how we start to transform the party in line with the radical democratic promise of Corbynism. Even at events like TWT Festival we have been unable to tie the potential of our movement together. As such, we are creating a new network inside the Labour Party. A network through which anti-capitalist members can coordinate and push for the changes we want to see. This network will operate on two terrains – inside the party; and in our communities and workplaces.

Our movement is capable of developing ideas and solutions; recent policy proposals such as 'Labour for a four day working week' and 'Labour for a green new deal' are a fraction of what our movement could achieve if the base was further empowered to dictate policy and could coordinate to deliver it. As such we need the space to come together nationally, thrash out our positions, and build and disseminate new ideas in line with our principles: inclusive democracy, internationalism and socialism.

Alongside a tighter coordination across our CLPs, we will link this network to extra-parliamentary groups who hold a belief in the self-management and self-emancipation of the working class. Members of the network will join these organisations' picket lines, direct actions and community drives, demonstrating our solidarity and helping to link these often disparate struggles into a coherent 'national' conversation. After all, socialism cannot, nor could it ever be limited to those inside the Labour Party.

We want a world where we all work less, where our material needs are met in full, where the planet doesn't burn, and where education and housing are free. We don't want to just work for the Party, we want the Party to work for us. We want real democracy and we want Socialism.
